

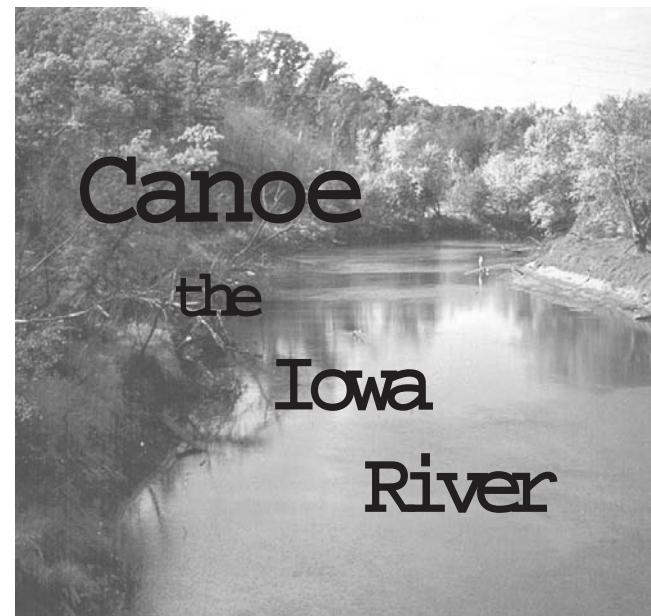
Access to the Iowa River

The Iowa River will pass through the Meskwaki Indian Settlement between McCoy access and Mannatts Landing. There are numerous tracts of state and federal land all along the remaining stretch of the Iowa River. This includes Otter Creek Marsh (on north side of river, between Long Point Landing and Duffus Landing) and numerous Iowa River Corridor wildlife areas interspersed with privately owned lands. Throughout the canoe trail, respect should be shown for the river, the adjoining land and its inhabitants. This applies to when you are passing through tribal, private, state or federal property.

*Average canoe paddle speed is about 2 mph, plus current speed of 1 mph when the river is at □ normal level. □ Anticipated rate of travel may range from 3 mph with stops to around 4.5 mph without stops along the way.

*Portions of the Iowa River can be quite challenging. Use caution when canoeing the river. Currents can be swift and there are numerous downed trees, some of which are submerged.
